1. Minutes of the January 19, 2011 meeting were approved as submitted.

## **New Business**

- 1. Faculty Senate has an issue regarding Sodexho offering a snack unit for the Stone Center area.
- 2. University has not reported salaries to the AAUP for publication in *The Chronicle*. Faculty Senate would like to formally request that salaries be reported. Dr. Turner recommended that the request be put in writing to her.
- 3. Debbie Taylor reported on issues with students getting parking tickets for parking in a zone where signs have been stolen.
- 4. Dr. Turner noted the resignation of Tim Long as SGA President. Charles Dixon, III, will become the new SGA President and Jason Sumner will become the VP of the Student Senate.
- 5. Dr. Turner proposed new unit called University College. This unit would be under Dr. Joe Delap and would assist undecided students, transfer students and dual enrolled students. Academic Council approved proposal.

- 6. Dr. Turner announced the new structure of the President's Cabinet which includes Administrative Council and Academic Council members. More information regarding the restructuring will be forthcoming.
- 7. Academic Council discussed current issues with the JSU Bookstore not having enough books for students with book vouchers and the unresponsiveness of the JSU Bookstore. Dean Graham suggested that faculty may put a desk copy of the text book at the reserve desk at the Library for students to use. (The faculty would need to provide the desk copy.)
- 8. Dr. Frank King suggested that copyright workshops be conducted on campus for faculty. Dean Graham agreed to offer workshops.
