# **Old Business:**

Minutes of the December 3, 2014 meeting were approved after adding Dr. Joe Delap to the *Travel Committee*.

Dr. Rebecca Turner introduced Mr. Don Thacker as the interim auditor. In turn, the council stated their names and titles and welcomed Mr. Thacker back to JSU.

Dr. Turner provided a copy of the new *Policy on Scholarships* and stated the policy has been approved by the president and posted on the website.

Dr. Turner gave the following update on ACHE:

- The Research Center for Veteran Support Services was approved at the last ACHE meeting.
- A NISP for Respiratory Therapy has been submitted to ACHE and will be discussed with the board at the January 26<sup>th</sup> Board of Trustees meeting.
- At the December 2014 meeting, ACHE announced JSU received three grants:
  1)IMPACTSEED, Renewal;
  2) AMSTI for MCETS, Renewal;

Dr. Turner addressed the Summer 2015 calendar and requested all to make certain their departments are aware of the changes; i.e. July 4 Week was deleted.

Dr. Turner introduced two policy changes from Graduate Council: 1) Maximum student load for graduate students is now thirteen hours in Fall, Spring, and May Full Summer; and 2) Academic forgiveness at the graduate level will be similar to undergraduate academic forgiveness effective Fall 2015.

Mr. Johnson stated that a survey was distributed campus wide to students and responses from those surveys were compiled for his report. Mr. Johnson will share the report with the Board of Trustees on January 26<sup>th</sup>.

Dr. Melanie Wallace announced the Faculty Senate will have their first meeting of the new semester next Monday, January 12<sup>th</sup>.
