



During March 2022, Jacksonville State University will be conducting an essay contest among current JSU undergraduate students to celebrate Women's History Month. Winning entries will receive a monetary prize and possible inclusion in a local publication.

Students should write a grammatically correct 1000 to 1200-words essay in answer to the following prompt:

What does the term "feminism" mean? How do you understand its goals and strategies? Do you consider yourself to be a feminist? Why or why not? How has feminism changed our society?

The five (5) paragraph essay method is a suggested style format; however, it is NOT required for contest consideration. Entries will be judged by a panel of JSU faculty and personnel of the Women's History Month Committee using an evaluation rubric.
