

During March 2022, Jacksonville State University will be conducting a drawing contest among Elementary school students to celebrate Women's History Month. Winning entries will receive a monetary prize and possible inclusion in a local publication.

Elementary Students (current 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> graders, for the purpose of this competition) should choose <u>a noteworthy, innovative</u> woman who you see as a hero and draw a picture of that woman on a letter size piece of paper.

All drawings should be accompanied by a sentence naming and describing the woman's accomplishments. (For the younger students, parents or teachers may help with the sentence.) Drawings should be colorful and can include pictorial references to the woman's importance/accomplishments. For example, a drawing of Mae Jemison might include a picture of a rocket.
