

Ms. Kincaid grew up in Tallahassee, Florida, until her family moved Richmond, Virginia. She attended Virginia Tech where, as a freshman, she was crowned homecoming queen. There she met the football team's quarterback - an Alabama boy - married him, and dropped out of college at nineteen. Her husband's job as a coach moved the family to several states, including Alabama where for a time he had a position in the coaching staff at the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa. She later went back to college and received a BA from Athens State College in 1987 and an MFA in fiction writing from the University of Alabama in 1991.

Ms. Kincaid's stories and poetry have appeared in several magazines, including The Oxford American, Southern Humanities Review, Carolina Quarterly, Southern Exposure, and Ontario Review. Her stories have also been included in such anthologies as New Stories From The South and Short Stories of the American South.
