GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS -- are primarily annual reports, studies, and statistics from the various departments and agencies of the government. They are cataloged and shelved like other books and microforms. (There is no separate collection of government publications in this library).

JOURNALS

Searching the Library Catalog by under the journal name can identify JOURNALS held by the library. Journal Titles on MATHEMATICS can be located in the Library Catalog by clicking on "Author/Title/Subject/Call Number" search type. Then click on the "Journal Title" radio button. Last, type in your journal title and press the enter key. Use these Electronic Databases to locate JOURNAL ARTICLES and other papers on MATHEMATICS: Elsevier Science Direct, MathSciNet, Wiley InterScience Mathematics and Statistics Journals
